Club History

More than one year has been traced for the formation of Hamble Club, but it is 1969 which is deemed to be correct. Formed as Hamble FC, they made steady progress through the Southampton Junior League before merging with a Sunday team called Hamble Club and adopted their current name in 1981. From the senior divisions, Hamble Club were promoted to the Hampshire League in 1993. They moved from their old Mount Pleasant base to the old College Fields and made a further move to what was then known as the Shell-Max Ground during the 2002/03 season, which remains their present home. Wessex members between 2004 and 2007, Hamble became Hampshire Premier League founders but failed to complete the 2012/13 season and had to start a division lower. This heralded the start of an upturn as they gained four promotions in five years, including one in their first season back in the Wessex League in 2017.

The Club was established in 1969, originally as a youth team. In 1993, they joined Division Three of the Hampshire League. The Club were Division Three champions in 1996/97 earning promotion to Division Two. In 2004, the Hampshire League merged into the Wessex League, with Hamble becoming members of the new Division Three. In 2006 the division was renamed division Two but at the end of 2006/07, the division was disbanded and the club became founder members of the Hampshire Premier League.

Hamble pulled out of the Hampshire Premier League during the 2012/13 season. Although they were readmitted the following season, they started in the newly formed second tier of the League, division One. The Club were Division One runners-up in the 2013/14 season and were [promoted to the senior division and went on to win the Senior Division in 2014/15. After finishing third the following season, they were promoted to Division One and then were Division One champions in 2016/17, earning promotion to the Premier Division.



Club History

Brockenhurst FC History 1898-2022

The club was founded in 1898 initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before the First World War to a site between the Rose & Crown and Snakecatcher Public Houses. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire Leagues before moving to play at Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after the Second World War they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane

in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Senior Cup. They moved between the Second & Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying endina defeat City. round. the in Bath run

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier League as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southamption DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex league Cup though unfortunately were beaten in both. In recent years the Club has been led by Manager Pat McManus who has just started his 9th Season at the helm as Manager, whilst rebuilding the Club with a good youth structure in place. During Pat's time in charge the Club has gone from strength to strength off the field with Chairmen Dave Stansbridge, Stan Reid & Ian Allan & the Club Committee leading the Club well.

During the past two Covid hit Seasons we have had some success, In the 19/20 Season we won the Bournemouth Senior Cup and last Season 20/21 we won the Hampshire FA Invitation Trophy as well as both our U18 & U17 Teams winning their Divisions.

At the start of Season 21/22 we appointed a new Chairman Chris Panayi and Vice Chairman Richard Hobbs, plus we made the Adult & Youth Clubs into One Club under the Brockenhurst Football Club Umbrella. This prompted a Season of good fortunes with the Club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell Cotes Cup in a penalty shoot out. The Future looks bright for The Badgers


